

# CONDUCT

In accordance with our Code of Conduct Policy, under no circumstance will disruptive behavior be tolerated at MNP Community & Sport Centre. This includes all areas on our premise, facility and in our parking lot. Disruptive behavior may include but is not limited to: rudeness, loud, vulgar and abusive language, physical abuse, and blatant disregard of MNP Community & Sport Centre policies. MNP Community & Sport Centre employees will follow our procedures which may include banning a disruptive individual for the rest of the day or up to a lifetime ban based on the severity of the conduct.

As we collaborate with you to host your special event, our team will strive to make your experience world class. As the event organizer, we ask for your support in respecting our facility, employees and other customers. Should any serious situations arise, we will bring them to your attention and we ask for your support in resolving them. It is understood that user groups who rent MNP Community & Sport Centre facilities must take PRIMARY responsibility for the behavior of those associated with them including their staff, coaches, parents, volunteers, officials, athletes and spectators. We appreciate your support in reminding your event group about our Code of Conduct Policy and their role in creating a safe, professional and positive atmosphere.

MNP Community & Sport Centre **has the right to charge an event host a \$100.00 maintenance fee (per day)** if the event group violates any of the points below:

- By encroaching on space prior to the start of the booking time. This includes warming up in the area. Warm up time should be accounted for in the time booked by the event group.
- By leaving any booked space in an unclean condition or not putting equipment away.
- By using or encroaches on a space not booked for their use (ie. designated public spaces or spaces booked out by other user groups).
- If there is damage to equipment, not utilizing provided garbage bins or leaving behind event supplies.
- If the event requires any last minute accommodations not previously requested by the deadline.
- If an event host is unable to supply a Competition Gate Volunteer.
- If items are left in a space after the event or beyond the scheduled pick up time.

Any additional charges will be levied after the event with notification from the MNP Community & Sport Centre.

MNP Community & Sport Centre will ensure user groups are provided with any updates to the code of conduct zero tolerance policy.
